The Tablet


- The tablet user experience expands the digital canvas and breaks the Web page metaphor

Free Your Desktop ... The Cloud is Calling The Real Cost of Cutting the Cord

Aside from many of the obvious productivity gains mobile computing provides, you should consider the potential pitfalls and hidden costs.

Productivity loss?

How much productivity could be lost by having employees use a device with applications that they also use for personal reasons and entertainment?

Ultimately, does this comes down to employee discipline and the much debated topic of acceptable-use agreements?







The Real Cost of Cutting the Cord

Security

This is the biggest issue/resistance small business owners have. How much risk is involved with employees having anywhere portals and accessing sensitive business data outside of the secure network.



The rule of threes:

- 1) Physical risk can it be stolen?
- 2) Data risk can he be compromised
- 3) Breach risk, can it be used to hack.

According to a recent report by McAfee, new instances of malware targeting mobile devices detected last year were up 46 percent over levels recorded in 2009.





How Smart Are Your Smart Devices?

About as Smart as Your Employees...

- ☐ Employee Downloads a virus when browsing to a non-secure site on his smart phone
- ☐ Employee leaves his tablet out at a party where people are passing it around and playing with it, thus exposing confidential company information
- ☐ Employee sets his netbook case down while using a public restroom and it ends up stolen. What information did they have access to?

The smartest devices are those with well-instructed owners. Preventative training and company policies make for very smart devices.

☐ Set Policy in Writing: What happens if the device is lost, stolen, or broken – who is responsible for replacement? What are the technology policies?



Smart Device Management – Happy Employees



- If employee loses a device, they are responsible for replacing 100%.
- If hardware fails, same subsidy split for replacement should be in effect.
- Before any devices are provided to the employee by the employer (or subsidized), a written use-agreement should be in place outlining these responsibilities.
- Outline must-have vs. nice-to-have tasks and demand for remote productivity.
- Does the employee need to check email after hours away from the office for urgent issues and/or projects? How often?
- Does the amount of work done remotely and/or after business hours outweigh the time lost from an occasional game of Angry Birds, text messaging, or Facebook time?







Social Media Can Be Very Unsocial - Limit Exposure, Set Policy

With deskless technology comes faceless, omnipotent social media. Exposure is great but deskless technology blurs the lines. Gain strategies for drawing boundaries.

- Create list of acceptable social media apps and implement policies in writing signed off by all employees
- Treat mobile devices at work same as desktops at the office. When at work, mobile devices are subject to company's acceptable use policy.
- A best practice for social media (i.e. Twitter, Facebook), consider using separate apps for business-only use. If the employee uses their mobile device for personal tweeting as well as business, consider using something like HootSuite's mobile app so they can keep it separate.
